❖ ENRICHMENT

Student Enrichment Program (S.E.P.) – This Communities In Schools program provides site coordinators on school campuses throughout Duval County, with the goal of providing critical services to students who are at-risk of falling behind or dropping out of school. While site coordinators work individually with select students from the school body, hundreds of others are reached through school-wide services such as career fairs, literacy programs and parent events.

❖ MENTORING



Achievers For Life (AFL) is a dropout prevention initiative developed and funded by the United Way of Northeast Florida, in partnership with Communities In Schools of Jacksonville and Jewish Family and Community Services. Achievers For Life targets sixth grade students exhibiting risk factors of school disengagement including low GPAs, low FCAT scores and excessive absences.

❖ AFTER SCHOOL



TEAM UP is an enrichment program providing a safe environment in which students can thrive during after school hours. The program starts with a snack, finishes with a hot meal and includes instruction for one hour each day by a certified teacher in language arts, science and math. In addition to these activities, students experience numerous activities such as choir, dance, sports and cheerleading.

❖ LITERACY



DUVAL READS! is a literacy program providing intensive one-on-one and small group reading tutoring to students, reading below grade level, in kindergarten through the eighth grade. The program's goal is to increase students' reading comprehension by at least one letter grade. Tutors work in the schools with their assigned students. DUVAL READS! is an AmeriCorps program that is organized and directed by Communities In Schools of Jacksonville.
