Communities In Schools of Jacksonville respects your concerns about privacy and values the trust you have placed in us. This Privacy Notice describes the types of personal information we collect, how we may use that information, and with whom we may share it. Our Privacy Notice also describes the measures we take to protect the security of your information. In addition, it describes the choices you can make about how we use the information you provide to us. We indicate how you can update your contact information, remove your name from our mailing list, and answer questions you may have about our privacy practices.

What types of information does Communities In Schools collect and use about me and how is that information used?

We collect and use information about you to communicate with you about our services and events, and to personalize that communication. We also collect information to improve your website experience, enroll Communities In Schools volunteers and youth, enable you to make donations to Communities In Schools, enable contact with Communities In Schools alumni, and enable you to stay informed on legislative issues important to Communities In Schools. Here are the ways we obtain information about you, the types of information we obtain and how we use the information:

Contact Us Link - If you contact us via our website, we may ask you for information such as your name, address and email address so we can respond to your questions or comments. Unless you consent, we do not retain this information except to respond to your inquiries.

Volunteering - When you enroll online to become a mentor or volunteer, we may ask you for your name, email address and phone number. If you are under 13 years old, we ask you to have your parent or guardian enroll you, or call us at 904 354-5918.

Donations – When you make a donation we may ask you for your contact information and credit card or checking information. We use this information to process your donation and to customize our communication with you.

FAQ's

Does Communities In Schools share the information it obtains about me with third parties?

Communities In Schools does not share personal information about you with any third parties for their own marketing purposes. We do share this information with service providers we have retained to perform services on our behalf. These service providers are not authorized by us to use or disclose the information except as necessary to perform services on our behalf or to comply with legal requirements. We may disclose information about you to other members of the Communities In Schools family (such as our National Organization, which may have their own privacy policies) and as required by law.

How does Communities In Schools protect personal information?

The security of personal information is a high priority for us. We maintain online safeguards to protect against unauthorized disclosure, use, alteration and destruction of the personal information in our possession. To protect the security of your credit card information, we use the industry standard for Internet security -- Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology. This Internet encryption standard scrambles data as it travels from your computer to our server. You'll know that you're in a secure area of our website when the "http" portion of the Communities In Schools website address in your browser changes to "https." The "s" stands for "secure."

How does Communities In Schools update its Privacy Notice?

Communities In Schools' products, services, promotions and programs will change over time. This Privacy Notice will be updated periodically to reflect those changes and corresponding changes in our information practices. Whenever we revise this Privacy Notice, we will change the date on the notice

to indicate when the revisions were made. We reserve the right to change our information practices and the terms of this Privacy Notice, and to apply the changed practices to all information we have about you.

Does the Communities In Schools website contain links to other websites?

The Communities In Schools website may contain links to other websites that operate independently of Communities In Schools and are not under our control. We provide links to those sites solely for your convenience and information. Those sites have their own privacy notices, which we suggest you review if you visit any linked sites. Communities In Schools is not responsible for information that is provided by those sites or for any other use of the sites.

How can I update my contact information?
